BOW ASSEMBLY

Limb Assembly – Figure 1

Use a hex wrench to tighten limb bolt in limb pocket for both the top limb and the bottom limb. Do not over tighten. For PSE Optima bows only: when assembling the bow, be sure to install washer between limb bolt and limb insert.

PSE strongly recommends using a bow stringer to safely string the bow and to eliminate twisting bow limbs. A bow stringer can be purchased from your local PSE dealer.

String Installation

- A) Place the larger loop of the bow string over the top limb, sliding it down slightly from the tip.
- B) Attach the smaller loop on the lower limb into the limb string notch.
- C) Insert the pocket of the bow stringer on the lower limb making sure it does not displace the string loop.
- D) Slide the gripper loop of the bow stringer over the top limb, just inside the loop of the bow string.

- E) Grip the handle of the bow and stand on the bow stringer with one foot.
- F) Pull upward on the handle to bend the bow limbs.
- G) When the limbs are sufficiently bent, slide the bowstring loop into the top limb notch. Check that the string loop is set in the limb string notch and relax the pressure on the bow. You can now remove the bow stringer.

THE BOW IS NOW ASSEMBLED

Make sure the string is correctly positioned. For good bow maintenance, we recommend that the bow be unstrung when not in use. Refer to the instructions above to disassemble the bow.

Tighten limb bolt with hex wrench. DO NOT over tighten.

For Optima bows only: Be certain the washer provided is between the limb bolt and the limb insert

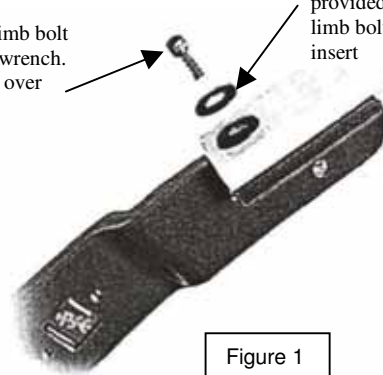

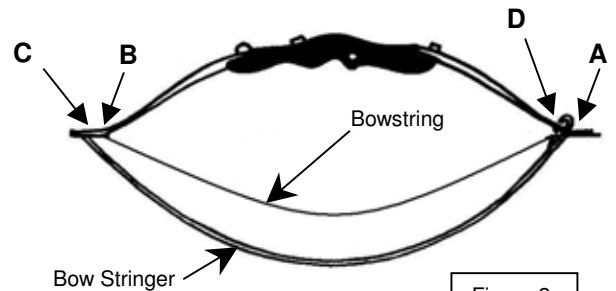

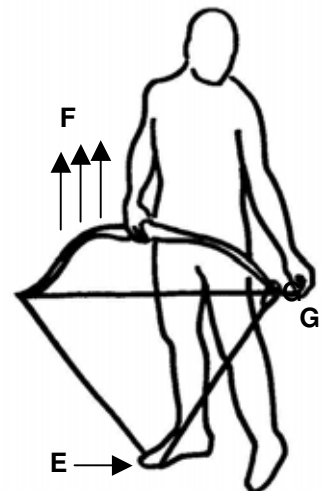
